This is the Place Heritage Park – Cost \$40 includes transportation

This Is The Place Heritage Park allows you to step back in time and see the West as it was in the early settlement of Utah, ride on one of three trains, visit the Native American Village, and try your hand at some old-fashioned pioneer chores. With over 50 historic homes and structures to visit and countless fun activities, This Is The FUN Place for Everyone!



Trolley Bus Tour – Cost \$35 (Limited to 28)

Travel through time in this classic trolley as you ride through the historical districts of Salt Lake City. Your colorful Conductor and magical Motorman will entertain you with dozens of tales in a theatrical fashion! See elegant mansions, ornate churches, grand architecture, and stunning mountain views. The Salt Lake Trolley Experience is a "Sightseeing Show" you'll never forget! This activity will depart directly from the Radisson Downtown.



Natural History Museum of Utah – Cost \$37.50 includes transportation

The Natural History Museum of Utah opened its doors to the public in the George Thomas Building in 1969. Since then, collections have been transferred from the University's academic departments and grown through research, acquisition, and contributions to number more than 1.6 million objects. The Museum has solidified its position as the state museum of natural history and has developed strong programs of exhibits and education, both on-site and statewide. In November 2011, we moved to a new home, the Rio Tinto Center, with entirely new exhibit galleries, engaging programs for the public and state-of-the-art collections care and research facilities. At this milestone in the Museum's rich history, we acknowledge that we are a work-in-progress. Join us for a guided tour to include the newest exhibit – Maya, Hidden Worlds Revealed.



Epic Brewery Tour/Tasting – Cost \$0 -

Epic is Utah's first brewery since prohibition to brew exclusively high alcohol content beer. Epic handcrafts and carefully bottles its unique product in 22-ounce bottles, perfect for sharing or a long savor, solo style. Epic Brewing Company opened in Salt Lake City, Utah with six fermentation tanks giving it the flexibility to create a variety of small batch, artisanal beer. Within a few short months, Epic began earning medals for its beers domestically and internationally. The beer became a big hit with locals and out of state visitors alike and demand quickly increased. The brewery currently houses eight times its original fermentation space.



Family History Library – Cost \$0 - No transportation required as this is within walking distance of the Radisson.

A less than 10-minute walk will take you to the world's largest genealogical library where experienced guides and genealogist can help you begin your journey of self and family discovery through fun and engaging activities. The library's collection includes about 1.4 million rolls of microfilm on-site, along with over 600,000 books, serials, and maps. In addition, guests have free access to billions of additional record images online. The Family History Library has 550 internet-enabled guest computers and over 200 microfilm and microfiche readers. The Library also offers free access to film, book, and photo scanning equipment to help our guests digitally preserve and share family records.



Ensign Peak Hike – Cost \$0 – Attendee will be responsible for transportation

Ensign Peak is at the north end of the Salt Lake Valley, above the State Capitol building. This easy 1-mile round trip hike provides the perfect way to view the city.
